2. Admission Process:

- (A) Admission and Counselling Process: The joint counselling for the admissions in all SIASTEs will be conducted in physical / face-to-face mode at DIET Gurugram. The schedule for this process will be displayed on the institute website: www.siaste.ac.in.
- (B) The counselling for admissions will held in the physical mode at **SIASTE Gurugram**, **SCERT Haryana Campus**, **Opposite Panchayat Bhawan**, **Gurugram** (Haryana)-122001.
- (C) During all rounds of counselling only the candidates who participated in CEE-2023 conducted by NCERT / RIE Bhopal will be considered. However, remaining vacant seats may be filled through open and mop-up rounds of counselling, notice for which will be issued separately. Institute reserves the right to revise the qualifications at any time before or during the counselling/admission process. If any dispute arises on eligibility of candidates the decision of

Director SIASTE shall be final.

4. <u>Scheme of Studies for the Programme</u>: The course will be conducted as per scheme of studies approved by the concerned affiliating university.

5. Eligibility for Admission:

(A) *Eligibility for B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme*:

- (i) Candidates seeking admission to Physical Science Group must have passed Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) (Mathematics includes Mathematics or Statistics) and those seeking admission to Biological Science Group (CBZ) must have passed Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) (Biology includes Biology or Biotechnology) at +2 level.
- (ii) Candidates must have passed +2 / Hr. Sec./ Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination recognised by University/ Board with at least 60% marks. The examination should be recognised by the concerned affiliating University of SIASTE.
- (iii) Candidates who have passed +2 or any equivalent examination in 2021, 2022 or appearing / appeared in 2023 only.
- (B) Eligibility for B.A. B.Ed. Course
 - (i) Candidates must have passed Hr. Secondary/Sr. Secondary or equivalent examination in Science, Arts and Commerce streams with at least 60% marks in 2021, 2022 or appearing / appeared in 2023 only.
 - (ii) The examination should be recognized by the relevant affiliating University of SIASTE.
 Note: The relaxation as per State Govt. of Haryana / affiliating University norms will be applicable to relevant categories.

6. Merit for Admission:

The admission in above programmes will be made on the basis of CEE-2023 score card. However, institute reserve the right to admit the students on the basis of marks obtained in 10+2/12th class board examination with following criteria during open/mop-up rounds:

- (i) For admission in B.Sc. B.Ed. (Non-medical/ Mathematical Science / PCM Group) only the marks obtained in three relevant subjects' viz. Physics/ Chemistry/Mathematics/Information Technology etc. will be considered.
- (ii) For admission in B.Sc. B.Ed. (Medical/ Biological Science /CBZ Group) only the marks obtained in three relevant subjects viz. Physics/Chemistry/Biology/Biotechnology etc. will be considered.
- (iii) For admission in B.A. B.Ed., the score of best five subjects, must including marks obtained in English subject, will be considered for preparation of merit.

7. <u>Reservation:</u>

Reservation in admission would be applicable as per Government of Haryana / affiliating university instructions issued from time to time. It is further made clear that benefit of reservation will be given to the candidates, who have Haryana domicile and/or have got the requisite certificate from Haryana State only. Further it is made clear that the certificate of OBC / SC / ST will be considered only for CEE-2023 and for "Admission and Counselling Process" of the institute only the certificates issued by competent authority for BC-A/BC-B of Haryana instead of OBC and SC/SC Deprived of Haryana instead of SC/ST will be considered valid. The EWS certificate having validity on the date of admission will only be considered for reservation in relevant category.

8. Documents Required at the time of Admission:

The Candidates should submit all original certificates/documents with self-attested copies of the testimonials at the time of admission along with six latest passport size photographs. Theywill also be required to submit the following documents. Candidates should retain a printed copy of the Application Form (duly filled in by the candidate)

- Score Card of CEE-2023 conducted by NCERT / RIE Bhopal indicating preference of SIASTE Haryana /Prarambh Jhajjar.
- (ii) Resident of Haryana: Self attested photocopy of Haryana Resident Certificate issued by the competent authority i.e., Deputy Commissioner/City Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Officer (civil)/ Tehsildar/ Naib Tehsildar/ Head of the department. In the case of candidate who has qualified the examination i.e., 10+2 from a school situated in Haryana for current year will produce a certificate issued by the principal of the concerned institution as resident certificate.
- (iii) Self-attested photocopy of 10+2/Sr. Secondary School Certificate issued by Board.
- (iv) Self-attested photocopy of the secondary certificate as a documentary proof of age and subject passing Hindi/Sanskrit.
- (v) Original copy of the certificate of good conduct issued by the Principal of theInstitution last attended or a Gazzetted Officer / MLA / MP.
- (vi) An affidavit regarding anti ragging from students & parents.
- (vii) A declaration / under taking from the students for abiding rules and regulation of SIASTE
- (viii) Migration certificate of Board of School Education concerned in original.
- (ix) Only two self-attested photocopy of the following certificates (belonging to reserve categories) is to be submitted along with the original certificates at the time of Admission/Counselling.
 - (a) For the candidates belonging to SC: copy of certificate issued by the competent authority i.e., Tehsildar/ Naib Tehsildar, Head of the Department- in case of Govt. employees.
 - (b) For the candidates belonging to BCA/BCB: copy of certificate issued by the competent authority i.e., Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar/Head of the Department-in case of Govt. employees.
 - (c) For the candidates belonging to Economically Backward Persons in the General Caste Category (EBPGC): copy of certificate issued by the competent authority i.e., Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar, Head of the Department - incase of Govt. employees as per the State Government instructions.
 - (d) **Physically Challenged (PHC)**: copy of certificate issued by Civil Surgeon of the District Concerned. The disability should not be less than 40%.
 - (e) For Dependent of children or grandchildren (Maternal/Paternal) claiming the benefit of Freedom Fighter: The certificate from Chief Secretary Haryana and relationship certificate from the Deputy Commissioner/competent authority.

(f) For Ex-servicemen & Dependent Ex-servicemen category: copy of certificate issued from the Zila Sainik/District Sailors and Soldiers Board.

Note:

- (i) Merit shall be sole criteria for admission in SIASTEs.
- (ii) Furnished false/fake information or certificate etc. or withheld/concealed information will attract cancellation of admission and legal proceedings as well.
- (iii) A minimum of 10 students will be have to take admission in a particular course/ stream, for making it operational and functional. In case the number of students taking admission in a particular stream is less than 10, then that particular stream will not be started and the admission fee deposited by the students will be refunded.

9. Fee Structure:

Institute charge fee of Rs. 18400/- annually which is submitted online only using Credit Card / Debit Card / Net-banking. Students offered seats during Physical Counselling will have to deposit the required fee through online mode on the spot/same day, failing which he/she will forfeit the claim of seat offered during counselling. Such students will not be allowed to participate in further rounds of counselling. Students are required to submit the fee at start of each year before a prescribed cutoff date. The fee may be changed at the discretion of Govt. institute management. In case a student withdraws the admission the refund of fee will be made out as per rules of Haryana Govt. / relevant affiliating University / Institute norms. The candidates are required to submit complete fee on the day of counselling, failing which the offer of admission will be withdrawn.

10. Anti-Ragging:

Institute has zero tolerance on ragging. Strict action will be taken against those involved in such nefarious activities including expulsion from institute. At the time of admission students / parents will have to submit an undertaking of anti-ragging.
